THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Rural Municipality of La Broquerie financially support the creation of an amalgamated Recreation and Community Service effective September 1st, 2014 by allowing the amalgamation of the present positions responsible for the operation of the CDC, the La Broquerie Arena and other volunteer recreation and community boards who wish to participate.
