- That an electronic and a hard copy of the plan of subdivision be provided;
- 4) That verification of proposed site areas and widths for all proposed lots be provided;
- 5) That the applicant obtains any and all variations deemed necessary in order to comply with our Zoning By-Law 5-96;
- 6) That the applicant obtains an Engineered Drainage Plan for this area;
- That development dedication fees be submitted to the municipality in the amount of \$1500.00 for each newly created building lot;
- 8) That the site be rezoned from "AC" Agricultural Conservation Zone to "RR2" Rural Residential;
- 9) That the applicant enters into a Development Agreement with the municipality;
- 10)That the strip of land providing access for proposed lot 2 be moved from the east to the west and be increased from 16 feet to 66 feet;
- 11)That monument restoration costs, for monuments that were found to be restored within this subdivision, will be borne by the Developer;
- 12)That any and all costs associated with this Subdivision will be borne by the Developer.
