THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT Administration be authorized to proceed with a final offer to the property owner, as discussed with Council, by a submission by the municipal solicitor;

AND FURTHER BE IT RESOLVED THAT J. R. Cousin Consultants be authorized to proceed with the Environment assessment application as outlined in Option 1 of the feasibility study.

WHEREAS the Rural Municipality of La Broquerie incurred the following audited deficits: 2008 \$91,867.00 (before transfer of \$55,250.00 from General Operating Fund) 2009 \$91,332.00 2010 \$123,083.00 (before transfer of \$44,440.00 from General Operating Fund);

AND WHEREAS the Rural Municipality of La Broquerie's most recent Utility Rate Study, approved by Public Utilities Board (PUB) Order 142/13, took into account the aforesaid deficits and utilized 2011 audited financial results;

AND WHEREAS the Rural Municipality of La Broquerie 2013 unaudited financial results and 2014 budget indicate the following deficits calculated on a PSAB basis;

2013 \$38,077 2014 \$79,884

AND WHEREAS the deficit incurred in 2013 and the budgeted deficit in 2014 are a result of significant upgrades to lift stations that will benefit existing and future customers of the utility;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Rural Municipality of La Broquerie withdraw the request for deficit authorization for 2008 and 2009;

AND FURTHER BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Rural Municipality of La Broquerie apply to PUB for authorization of the unaudited deficit of \$38,077.00 and the 2014 budgeted deficit of \$79,884.00;

AND FURTHER BE IT RESOLVED THAT PUB be requested to authorize a rate rider to recover the 2013 actual and 2014 budgeted deficits over a 3-year period resulting in an annual charge of \$45.62 per residential equivalency unit.
